PART 1: Rules and Regulations

1.1 Regulations:

This is a UCI Class 2 event, held under UCI regulations and USAC Permit. The UCI scale of penalties shall apply.

1.2 Participation:

1.2.1 Categories:

The UCI C2 events are open to UCI Elite Men and Elite Women categories.

A UCI or USAC International license is required to participate in the Elite Men and Women categories.

The UCI Elite Men race is open to UCI licensed riders with a racing age of 19 or above. The Elite Women race is open to UCI licensed riders with a racing age of 17 or above.

An ACA license required for all other categories. A one-day ACA license (\$10.00 extra) will be available at on-site registration/packet pick up at the Xilinx Campus.

Racing age: A rider's racing age for all categories is determined by his/her age on December 31, 2010.

1.2.2 Registration:

Pre-registration is available through bikereg.com. Online registration closes 12:00 midnight EST Thursday, October 29, 2009. **Registration for the UCI Elite Men/Elite Women categories is pre-registration only. There will be no day-of-race registration for UCI categories.**

Early number pick-up will be available on October 30th at the Xilinx campus (3100 Logic Drive, Longmont), from 5pm to 9pm.

Day-of-race registration (\$10 late fee) will only be available for ACA categories and opens at 7:00am with priority given to the 8:00am starting wave at the Xilinx campus and closes 30 minutes prior to your race. License check/packet pickup for UCI categories opens at 12:00 noon at the Xilinx campus and closes **one hour** prior to your race.

Registration for the UCI Elite Men/Elite Women categories is pre-registration only. There will be no day-of-race registration for UCI categories.

1.3 Race Headquarters & Press Room:

Race Headquarters & Press Room will be located at the Xilinx Retreat Building – 3100 Logic Drive.

1.4 Anti-Doping:

UCI races are conducted under USA Cycling, UCI and USADA anti doping regulations. Riders must check to see if they are required to submit to doping control. Doping Control will be located in the Xilinx campus building – 3100 Logic Drive.

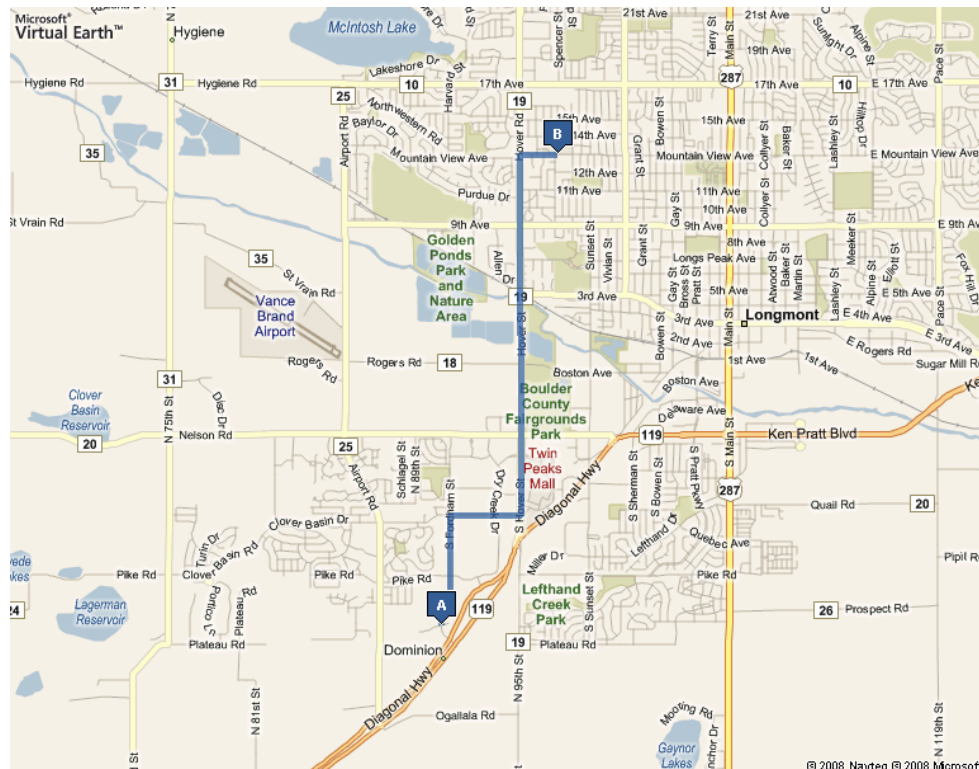
1.5 First-Aid/EMT's:

If there is life threatening emergency dial 911. There will be an EMT on site. First-Aid will be available in the vendor area that is adjacent (south side) to the Finish Line. Look for the RED CROSS. In the case of a non-emergency, the nearest hospital is Longmont United Hospital, located at 1950 Mountain View Avenue, Longmont, CO. Non emergency contact is 303-651-5111.

Start at: 3100 Logic Dr Longmont, CO 80503

1. Head North on Logic Drive toward South Fordham Street
2. Turn right onto Clover Basin Drive
3. Turn left at Hover Street
4. Turn right at Mountain View Avenue. Hospital will be on the left

Arrive at: 1950 Mountain View Ave Longmont, CO 80501



1.6 Number Placement:

UCI Race Numbers - Bib numbers are to be placed on your LEFT and RIGHT side. **Bicep** numbers shall be worn on the upper forearm/shoulders so it is visible frontally. Riders shall ensure that their number is visible and legible at all times. Numbers folded, altered or not well fixed will result in a fine according to USAC & UCI regulations.

ACA Race Numbers - Bib number is to be placed on your RIGHT side. Do not fold your number.

1.7 Start Order & Staging Protocol:

UCI Categories - UCI rule 5.1.043 – Elite: The start order will be determined by the order of latest published UCI cyclocross point classification from highest to lowest, as posted on the UCI website www.uci.ch. Riders without UCI point, according to order of registration/bib number.

ACA Categories – Call-ups will be based on current top 20 BCR ranking, then by order of registration/bib number.

1.8 Lapped Riders in UCI Events (UCI Rule 5.1.051):

Each rider lapped before the final lap must leave the race the next time they cross the finish line. He shall be listed in the results with his total number of laps behind the winner. A rider who is lapped on the final lap shall be stopped at the beginning of the finishing straight line and shall be given a placing on the basis of his position.

Lapped Riders in ACA Events: Lapped riders will finish on the same lap as the leaders. Riders in danger of being lapped must yield to oncoming racers and are not to interfere with their progress or trail behind them. ACA race officials have LAST CALL on who is pulled in the all the categories.

1.9 Pit and Bike Washing Area:

Bike wash will be available near the pit.

1.9.1. Pit Pass & Mechanic's Protocol:

Mechanics passes will be issued at Registration/Package Pick-up. Each rider has a right to only one assistant in the pit area. No other personnel will be allowed in the pit zone. Bike changes may only take place in the pit areas.

1.10 Prizes See table below

1.10.1. Awards Area:

Riders finishing in the top 3 (top 5 for UCI categories) shall report IMMEDIATELY to the podium waiting area. Only riders and staff are allowed in the podium waiting area. NO EXCEPTIONS.

2.1 Length:

The course is ~3.3K (2.1 miles) long. The Start/Finish area is pavement and ~250 meters long. The course will have a double pit.

2.2 Description:

2% Sand
 28% Pavement
 70% Grass

2.3 Warm-ups:

Course shall be open for warm up at the following times:

10/31 – 7:00 am to 7:45 am

10/31 – 1:30 pm to 2:00 pm

NOTE: Warming up on the course while a race is in progress is strictly prohibited.

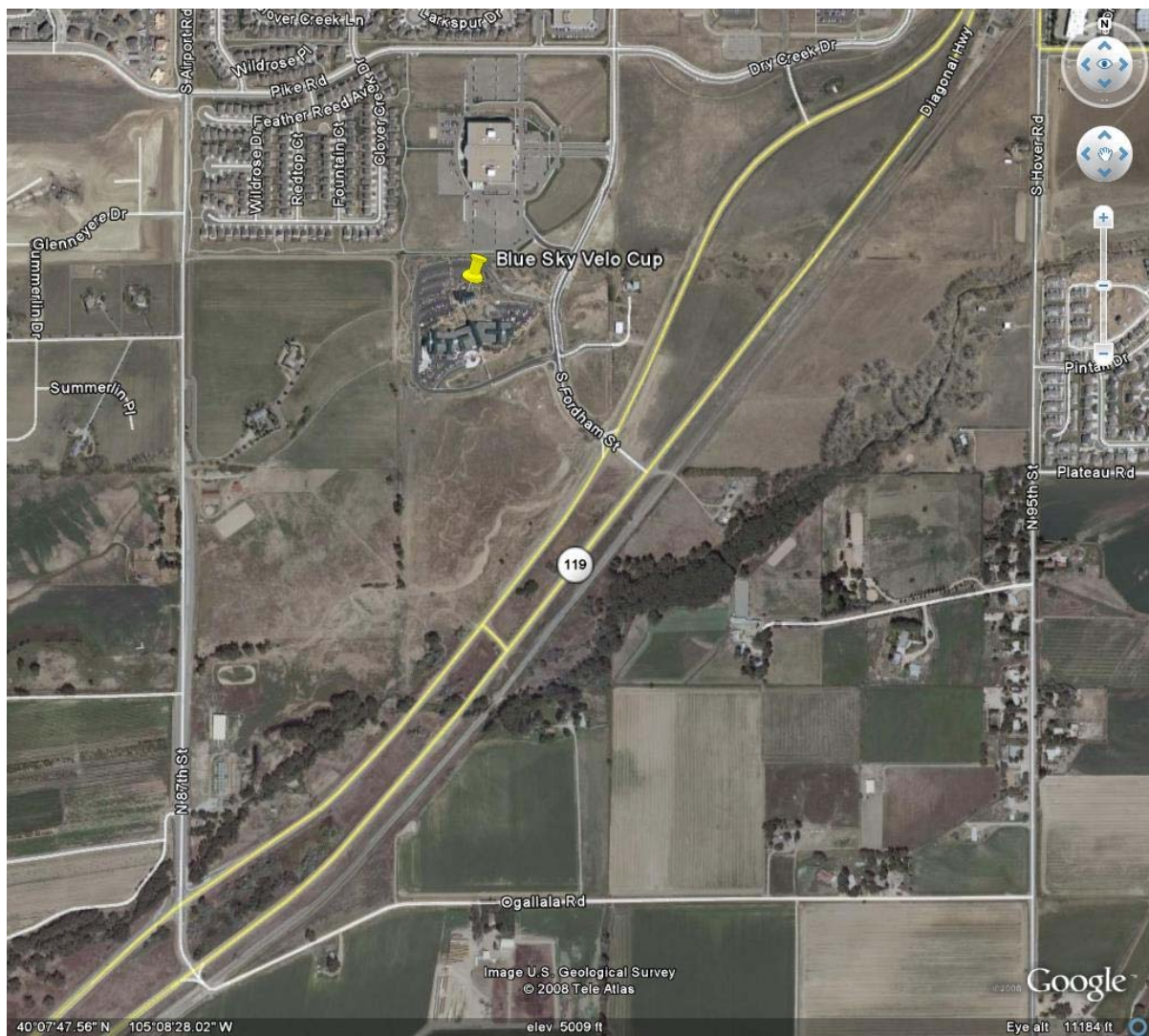
Part 3: Directions and Map
